**Abstract:** Attempting to establish feasibility of using satellite data to map ticks and incidence of Lyme Borreliosis, the LymeMAP project engages with communities and key stakeholders in the Highlands to explore how such data might be used, and how users could interact with a potential resulting product.

Focus group style workshops, hosted in four locations across the Highlands, encourage stakeholders to become involved in directing the project in an iterative process that allows findings from each of the workshops to inform each stage of development.
